

## TECHNOLOGY HELP SHEET FOR LNES PARENTS

### SCHOOLOGY

- What is Schoology?
  - Schoology is a learning management system (LMS) that connects all the people (teacher, student, parent, administrators), content, and systems that fuel education.
  - Students, teachers and courses are populated into Schoology through PowerSchool, student information system (SIS)
  - Parents connect into Schoology by creating accounts which connect them to their child(ren). They will see what courses and groups their child is enrolled into throughout their education career at Nazareth (K-12)
- Parent Access Schoology – <https://www.schoology.com/>
  - Create Account
    - Use Email for Username
    - Create Password
    - Join Code for Each Child
      - Parent will receive once child is enrolled and assigned in a class
    - One Log-in Created will access all children in district
      - If parent already has a Schoology account due to having a student in the district, only need to Add a Student once logged into School under the drop-down arrow next to their name in the top right side of the screen

  - Username – ID Number
  - Password – Random Word with Number assigned to student by district
  - Parents and Students Access Schoology through two different websites

### POWERSCHOOL

- Parent Access
  - Letter will be sent home with Access ID and Access Password that will be used for parent to create their own log-in for PowerSchool
  - If parent already has a log-in, but a new student is entering the district; parent can log-in and add the student using the Access ID and Password
  - Parent can access all their children through one log-in in PowerSchool
- Student Access
  - Username – ID Number
  - Password – Random Word with Number assigned to student by district

- Go to Main Office
  - Must Present Driver License or Photo ID
- Information cannot be given over phone or through Email.
- Can be sent home with student

## GOOGLE

- Each student has a Google Account
- Students cannot receive Email from anyone through the Gmail in Elementary School
- Student will have account through their time in the Nazareth Area School District
- Student type in their entire Email ([Student#@nasdstudents.org](mailto:Student#@nasdstudents.org))
- Students will then be prompted to type in Password which is their same password to log into school, Schoology and PowerSchool
- Students have unlimited storage under their school Google account throughout their education career in the district

## REMIND

- Used to send text message or Email
- User can sign-up and remove themselves
- May be used by faculty and/or administration to keep parents and students informed

## CLEVER

- Single Sign-on for some of our Applications
  - Lexia
  - Benchmark Universe
  - First in Math
  - Other applications can be added in the future
- Students in K-3 receive a badge to use in school to log into the Chromebooks and then automatically logs them in to their Clever dashboard
  - Badge has a QR Code specific for each student
  - Badge also has student's name, username (ID number) and password (word with number) to log into computers without a camera to detect the QR Code

## GENERAL KEYBOARD KNOWLEDGE

- It is helpful for students to have a general knowledge of the number keys order across the top of the keyboard
- It is also helpful for students to know where the letters are on the keyboard to help them quickly log-in, if needed, and for keying in information
  - Learning the keyboard sheets and hints are available under Student Resources in the Drop-down Menu
  - Please note: This section of the website is to help students as to the location of keys on the keyboard in order to locate keys faster, NOT to teach touch typing.
  - Some touch typing sites are available under Student Resources.
